Who can enter: Current ESA members between the ages of 12 and 21 years.

Scholarship prize: \$500 will be awarded to one winner to be used to reimburse coaching fees with an EA accredited coach.

Cost to participants: It does not cost anything to enter. Up to 10 will be selected to receive intensive coaching from a world renowned coach.

What is expected of finalists?

Finalists will need to arrive at the venue and be ready to start at 9.00am each day and remain on site until the conclusion of each day.

You must attend all coaching sessions whether riding or not.

You will be assessed over the duration of the weekend by the Coach and Selector on performance, horsemanship, knowledge of discipline, attitude, ability and potential.

All finalists are required to attend the Equestrian SA Annual Awards Night to be held in early 2017. It is a condition of attending the scholarship weekend that participants attend this evening at own cost.

Persons under 16 years must be supervised by parent or guardian outside of scholarship training hours.
