RING 2 Encourage Competitors must be member of ESA, SHC, HIA &/or PONY CLUB or ADULT RIDING CLUB in casual dress, Safe Riding Boots and Helmets are required.

Competitors must start and finish in the same ring and are not allowed to compete on the same mount in both rings (except for class 46 Fancy Dress where all competitors are eligible)

Interschool classes will be held. Please pre-register your expression of interest in competing in these classes on or before the 23/02/2017. Eligibility and general particulars relating to the Interschool competition are at the bottom of the program.

Winners from all classes in Ring 1 will be eligible to compete in the Supreme Class for the relevant class section.

Riding Boots and Safety Helmets must be worn in this ring. Casual Summer attire. Riders to be 16 years and under. Dress will not be taken into consideration. Plaiting is optional. Children may be assisted by an adult. Under 4s must be accompanied by an adult. Led riders to be under 12 years. If a rider competes in a class led by an adult – they will be led for the remainder of the day.

First Ridden Pony Classes: These classes are for riders on the lead who are having their first few times off the lead. These riders generally are not riding off the lead at shows and winning open classes off the lead. Walk/Trot on circle only. Standard first ridden workout, which is walk away from the judge. Riders only canter if they are capable and want to.

Interschool

There will be a ridden and an in-hand phase. During the ridden phase, the horse and the rider's ability are individually scored. During the in-hand phase both the horse and the handler's ability are judged. Ribbons will be awarded for each phase: Horse, Rider, In-hand. The highest overall point score for all three phases is the overall Champion.

Conditions of Entry

Each horse and rider combination competing in official Interschool classes must nominate and pay a registration fee to the ESA office prior to close of entries for the event. Riders competing in multiple events during the season can pay a seasonal registration fee of \$40, which allows them to compete in all events for their discipline for the season. Alternatively, a registration fee of \$10/event may be paid.

Competitors competing in Interschool classes are representatives of their school. Please refer to the ESA website for interschool nomination forms.

Competitors are responsible for knowing and complying with all EA rules. Making an entry for Interschool competitions constitutes implicit acceptance of the Rules by both the rider and their parent/guardian.

- Interschool classes are conducted in accordance with the EA National Interschool Rules (effective 1 July 2017) and the relevant discipline National rules.
- 2. Riders taking part in the Event must be either members of the hosting club/event or junior members of Equestrian South Australia (ESA), as per the entry requirements of the event.
- 3. Rider's Age Riders who are 12 years of age as at January 1st 2018 must compete in **Secondary classes**. Riders who turn 12 during 2018 may compete in **Primary classes**. If a rider is 12 years of age as at January 1st 2018 and the rider is still in primary school, the rider may apply to Interschool SA for an exemption. The same applies for the Australian Interschool Championships. This ruling is in line with National guidelines.
- 4. Riders competing at this event may qualify for selection onto the South Australian Interschool Team. Visit the Equestrian SA Website for a copy of the selection policy.
- 5. Riders must complete the registration for Interschool form prior to the event, and pay the relevant fee. Either \$40 for the season, or \$10 per event.
- **6.** The school consent form must be completed with the registration form.
