October 2022

- EO now a qualified Child Safety Officer. EO now working with DC's to have a Child Safety Officer on each committee. Discussion regarding insurance and notifying affiliates re Child Safety Officer requirements.
- EA working on a new Disciplinary policy to replace the current MPP. Feedback provided from the States to Integrity.
