To be run in accordance with EA National Show Horse Rules available on the ESA Website.

Requirements for Qualifications (Southern Cross and ESA HOTY) and Highpoint Competition

Exhibits must be registered with the Equestrian Australia Ltd and owner/lessee must be a financial member of Equestrian Australia.

Registration papers must be in the name of the owner or lessee at the time of entry. All owners/lessees listed on current registration papers must hold a current EA membership at the time of entry.

All riders must be EA members as at the time of entry.

Requirements for competition

Any person riding on the grounds must be an EA member, or have paid Day/Event Membership.

Exhibits must be 3 years of age or over on 1st August 2021. No stallions are permitted.

Children's Classes

Open to exhibits ridden by children aged under 18 as at 1 January 2022.

Show Horse Classes:

Refer to NSH Rules. Show Hunters ineligible to compete if already competing in Show Hunter classes.

Show Hunter

Refer to NSH Rules. Show Horses ineligible to compete if already competing in Show Horse classes.

<u>Newcomer</u> means an exhibit that has not competed in ANY SADDLE CLASS, EVENT, OR DISCIPLINE UNDER SADDLE in any State/Territory prior to 1 Jan 2022 (excluding horse racing). The horse's first competition can be this event. The horse must be shown in a snaffle bridle. The horse may compete in the Open section at this event.

These classes are qualifiers for the Southern Cross Show Horse Spectacular and therefore run under the definition as stated by ENSW

<u>Owner Rider:</u> 'Horses must be owned and registered in the name of the rider or an immediate family member (mother, father, brother, sister, grandmother, grandfather). Leased horses are ineligible for these events'

<u>A professional</u> - any person (regardless of age) who derives ANY income/payment/renumeration (including contra type payments in goods or kind) for providing horse related services in the capacity of an owner/rider/trainer/breeder or producer of any horse in any discipline or horse sport/endeavour. Sponsorship in this case is not considered as payment/income/renumeration.

<u>Amateur/Home Produced:</u> the horse can not be ridden/produced/owned or part owned by a professional currently or in the previous 6 months.

<u>General Conditions</u>: Between the time of the schedule being published to the end of the event; entrants, riders and their families/associates are prohibited from contacting event judges. If the organising committee believes on reasonable grounds that this rule has been breached, the relevant entry will be disqualified from the event.

<u>Conflicts of Interest</u>: The event will be run in accordance with the EA Conflict of Interest Policy. For a copy of the EA Conflicts of Interest policy go to the Equestrian Australia Website.

<u>Measuring:</u> All exhibits entered in any Show Horse, Show Hunter, Leading Rein, Newcomer class must have a current EA Height Certificate at the time of entry. Refer to the EA Measuring Rules for requirements.

<u>Swabbing</u>: The use of prohibited substances in your horse is strictly prohibited. Random swabbing of horses will be conducted in accordance with the EA Medication Control Policy.

<u>Protests:</u> Protests in respect of any matter occurring during or in connection to this event must be made to the Ground Jury during its period of Jurisdiction. All protests must be in writing, signed by the person making the protest (must be 18 years or over) and accompanied by any supporting evidence, including the names and contact details of any witness, any statement from any witness. All protests are to be accompanied with a \$100 fee. Should the protest be upheld, a full refund will be issued. Unsuccessful protests will forfeit the full protest fee. Protests against any of the following matters may only be lodged with the Ground Jury and within the following time limits: a. Protests concerning the eligibility of a competitor or horse or to the conditions of the arena: not later than 30 minutes before the start of the relevant class or competition; b. Protests concerning irregularities or incidents during a class or competition, or the classification of a class or competition: not later than 60 minutes after the results of such class or competition.

Ground Jury: The Ground Jury consists of all officiating judges for the competition.

<u>Cruelty</u>: This event is run under the 2021 EA National Show Horse Rules, EA General Regulations 2010 and all other EA policies and bylaws FEI Statutes, General Regulations; FEI Veterinary Regulations; Competitors are advised to be aware of the current Rules. The onus is on the rider to know the rules under which they compete. No cruelty will be tolerated. Any rider/handler engaging in practices that the ground jury/organising committee consider to be cruel or any practice that falls within the EA guidelines for cruelty will be asked to leave the event whether they have competed in their respective class or not.

<u>Disclaimer of Liability</u>: To the maximum extent permitted under law, EA, ESA and the Show Horse Working Party Volunteers and the Event Organisers exclude liability for any accident, damage, loss, theft, injury or illness (whether direct or consequential) caused to any person, animal or property whatsoever.

Close of Entries Monday 7th March 2022 - No late entries will be accepted.

<u>Changes to submitted entries:</u> All scratchings, rider or horse substitutions prior to Friday 18 March must be made in writing to showhorse@equestriansa.com.au Any changes once competition has begun must be made in person to the chief Ring Master. No rider or mount substitutions will occur without prior approval.

<u>Refund Policy</u>: Entry fees will not be refunded after the close of entries unless a veterinary or medical certificate is provided within 48 hours of event conclusion. Scratching prior to the close of entries must be in writing to the organising committee.

By completing an online entry, you acknowledge and agree that you have read and accept the schedule rules including all class restrictions and requirements. It is the responsibility of the competitor to ensure their entries are correct and complete. At no time do Show Horse South Australia, Equestrian South Australia or the Event's Officials and Volunteers tolerate aggressive, offensive or harassing behaviour. Should this occur they have the right to deny any entries regardless of the reason.

<u>Privacy Statement:</u> The information you have provided to Show Horse SA will be used to administer your entry, as well as maintaining information about qualifications and insurance (if applicable). Your information may also be disclosed to any entity that may subsequently administer the Event or is required or authorised by law. To be judged at the completion of each section

The lucky winner of any Jackpot class is ineligible to compete in further Jackpot classes at this show.

Jackpot Classes \$20 entry fee per class

Class 1J - JUNIOR SHOW HUNTER - to be ridden by a rider under 18 years. Open to all hunter ponies, hunter hacks and hunter galloways. Winner will take the pool for this class

Class 2J - SHOW HUNTER - to be ridden by a senior rider 18 and over. Open to all hunter ponies, hunter hacks and hunter galloways. Winner will take the pool for this class

Class 3J - AMATEUR/HOME PRODUCED SHOW HUNTER - to be owned and ridden by an amateur (see competition guidelines for ESA definition of an amateur)

Open to all hunter ponies, hunter hacks and hunter galloways. Winner will take the pool for this class

Class 4J - JUNIOR SHOW HORSE - to be ridden by a rider under 18 years. Open to all show ponies, show hacks and show galloways. Winner will take the pool for this class.

Class 5J - SHOW HORSE - to be ridden by a senior rider 18 and over. Open to all show ponies, show hacks and show galloways. Winner will take the pool for this class

Class 6J - AMATEUR/HOME PRODUCED SHOW HORSE - to be owned and ridden by an amateur (see competition guidelines for ESA definition of an amateur)

Open to all show ponies, show hacks and show galloways. Winner will take the pool for this class
