520.4	EA Minimum Eligibility Requirements	Clarification of current rule	 520.4 Short Format CNC For 105 if a rider has 15 MER's at the level over a rolling 8 year period then this deems the rider established. For a horse and rider to start at 105 they must have 3 qualifying results in official EVA 95 (or grade 2 Pony Club competition or NSW B Grade Pony Club). One of these results may not have more that 20 Cross Country jumping faults. The other 2 must be clear of Cross Country faults and at least 1 of these must be at an official EA competition. Unless the rider is categorised at 105 or above.
