EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

EQUESTRIAN SA - STATE SELECTOR (JUMPING)

Expressions of interest are sought from the Equestrian SA community to fill the positions of State Selector (Jumping) as all positions are now declared vacant.

SUMMARY OF THE POSITION

The jumping committee will appoint a minimum of 2 maximum of 5 state selectors not including the chair of selectors for a two (2) year term commencing Jan 1 in even years.

The State Selectors will report to the Discipline Committee (Jumping SA) via the Chairperson of Selectors. The chairperson of the jumping committee is by virtue of office the chairperson of the state jumping selectors. The chairperson may delegate this responsibility to another member of the selection committee.

The selectors work together to identify teams for major competitions, by attending particular events and assessing performances. Selectors are also involved in the selection of individual competitions and/or teams for other competitions (e.g. Competitions on borrowed horses) as required.

Selectors also identify and select elite and talent squads, in accordance with the selection criteria and policy document of the jumping committee.

Selectors must meet in person at least twice per annum.

The State Selectors will monitor individual performances of riders and their horses for inclusion on State Squads and State Teams competitions. Selectors should be present at most competitions in SA, holding classes that accrue points for our State annual awards such as the Balharry and Fosters Cup.

The role will also include, but is not restricted to, assisting the Jumping Squad Coordinator with squad activities; selection and recommendation for other events/activities relevant to the sport such as selection of Youth Development Scholarship finalists.

ESSENTIAL REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must fulfil the following essential requirements to be eligible as a State Selector:

- Must be a minimum of 18 years of age.
- Must be a financial member of Equestrian SA minimum Participant level.
- Must have a good knowledge and experience of the attributes required for horses and riders.
- Must have a good knowledge of the jumping rules and governance.
- Must have good communication and interpersonal skills.
- Must attend and watch relevant classes at SA competitions on a regular basis.
- Must declare any and all conflicts of interests.
- Must be able to maintain committee confidentiality.

DESIRABLE EXPERIENCE

Applicants must demonstrate at least one of the desirable experience requirements to be considered as a State Selector:

- Successfully competed in Jumping at a minimum standard of 140cm+.
- Accredited Course Designer with experience at State Championship level.

HOW TO APPLY

Interest applicants are asked to complete the attached Expression of Interest page in no more than 250 words and forward to the Jumping SA Secretary via the Equestrian SA Branch Office by the due date. The Jumping SA Committee will nominate and recommend the successful applicants. All applicants will be duly advised of the outcome.
