RULES & REGULATIONS

- <u>LIABILITY</u> Neither the committee, nor any of the staff shall be in anyway liable for accident, injury, damage, loss or any matter that may happen for any causes or circumstances whatsoever to exhibitors, competitors, or members or their agents or to anyone on the grounds or to any animal or article exhibited or to any property brought onto the grounds or for any other loss, claim, matter, circumstances or event whatsoever in connection with or arising out of or understood to be the Kulpara Show Jumping Spectacular or any journey to or from the event.
- 2. All riders and owners of horses competing in Official Classes in Ring 1 must be current financial members of the EA. Riders competing in Unofficial classes must be members of either the EA, an affiliated club of EA or PCASA.
- 3. All riders and/or guardians for those under 18 years of age, must sign a Waiver of Liability/Member Release Form and agree to abide by the rules, regulations and conditions set down by the Kulpara Show Jumping Club Inc. Committee.
- 4. All horses nominated in Official classes in Ring 1 must hold current registration and grading card from the Equestrian Federation of Australia. Grading shall be in accordance with the National Grading System.
- 5. The same horse may be ridden by a Senior and a Junior rider over the duration of the Competition but not in the same class.
- 6. Horse/Rider combinations may compete in only one of Class 13, 14 or 15. Horses can upgrade classes but not down Grade.
- 7. Horses are restricted to 3 competition starts per day.
- 8. Dress standard as per EFA regulation and summer alternative dress will apply.
- 9. The committee reserves the right at their absolute discretion to alter or amend any of the conditions, regulations or any aspect of the event as they see fit.
- 10. The committee reserves the right to refuse entries and also the right to swab horses.
- 11. Any entries received on the day of the event will incur a \$2.00 late fee per horse per class
- 12.DOGS: Dogs to be restrained on a leash at all times.
- 13. Any changes or late Entries will go last on Draw and first in jump -off, if applicable.
- 14. <u>SCRATCHING/ALTERATIONS</u>: 75% of entry fees will be refunded if veterinary or medical certificate is produced. Alterations for any event will be accepted up until 1 hour prior to the commencement of the event.
- 15. All Riders MUST pay a \$20.00 helpers fee. Please nominate on your Entry form which event and Ring you (or a Helper) would like to help with the event. Upon doing this, your \$20.00 will be refunded.
- 16. OBJECTIONS: Objections addressed to the ground jury must be lodged in writing accompanied by a deposit of A\$100.00 within the following time limit –
- a) Objections against eligibility to a competitor or horse not later than one hour before the start of the competition;
- b) Objections to an obstacle or to the course or the length or the plan of the course immediately after the inspection of the course and before the start of the competition;
- c) Objections concerning irregularities or incidents during the competition as soon as possible after the end of the competition and not later than half an hour after the announcements of the results;
- d) The period of jurisdiction of the Ground Duty extends from one hour before the start of the competition until half an hour after the announcements of the final results for which the Ground Jury have been appointed.
- e) The appeal committee shall deal with appeals against decisions of the Ground Jury with objections referred to it and with all cases of infringement to the FEI regulations and rules for which the Ground Jury are not responsible. All appeals must be in writing accompanied by A\$100.00;
- f) The federation extends no responsibility for the loss or damage to any exhibit; and
- g) The committee reserves the right to accept or reject any entry or to vary conditions to any Class, to cancel any event or class without assigning any reason.

All Events in Ring 1 and Ring 2 will be run under EA Rules and Regulations.
