All horses to have their bridle number displayed at all times Contact for scratchings on the morning of competition is 0408 438 232 (text message preferred)

#### \* Please remember to bring water for your horse \*

No Horses to be in hand in the warm up area outside of familiarisation. No Horses permitted past the arena boxes bordering the warm up until

their scheduled competition time

Riders must report to the secretaries office before competing \*Please make sure you have ambulance cover\*

# Risk Management Checklist

- \* There will be a Risk Management Officer will be on site and available to answer/rectify problems as soon as practicable.
- \* Emergency Phone numbers for Doctor, Ambulance, Hospital will be at Secretary's desk.
- \* A First Aid Kit is available.
- \* Please keep Entry/Exit gates closed at ALL times.
- \* Observe Speed 10km/hr Limit within Dressage Grounds.
- \* Parking Areas as defined please follow marshalls directions.
- \* Fill in any holes your horse/s may dig. Spread manure.
- \* Lunging will only take place in the designated lunging area. You are considered to be lunging your horse if the horse is more that 2m away from you regardless of whether you are using a lunging rope of a training rope.
- \* Horses found to be posing a danger to other horses/persons on the Grounds, will be asked to remove them by the Risk Management Officer.
- \* Riders should you be involved in an incident while on the grounds please remember to report and fill in an incident report form at the office.
- \* In order to avoid incidents in the warm up area please pay extra attention to your lines and spacing and make sure you are familiar with the section "Etiquette for Warm-Up Arena" of EA the rule book.
- \* Your co-operation in these matters will be appreciated so that a good time will be had by all.

Royal Valuta AKA Peanuts was bred in Echunga by a dear friend of mine Jenny Edwards. I saw him when he was about 6 months old and instantly fell in love with him. His sire is the gorgeous Royal Hit and he is out of a Valuta mare. Jenny weaned him and bought him to my house when he was 9 months old. He was my dream horse, I enjoyed every moment I could get to know him as he was growing up. He watched me from the gate as I rode the children's ponies waiting for his turn.

In January 2014, Peanuts was 2, I was diagnosed with terminal bowel cancer and all my dreams of ever riding him vanished. I had surgery within days and started chemotherapy soon after. In May 2014 I had a liver resection to remove cancer from my liver but I knew after that that I would still try to break him in and go as far as I could until I needed help. I had nothing to lose. In August 2014, Peanuts officially turned 3 and I slowly started to break him in. He made everything so easy, I don't think he even felt me up there much,

I weighed 43kg and I probably felt like a fly. But his temperament allowed me to do all of it myself with the help of friends and coaches.

The AOR Pryde's high point series over the last two years have given me a goal and I am incredibly grateful for that. Some days, I found it hard to continue riding this massive giant who just wouldn't stop growing despite me pleading him. He is strong and not always keen to give me what I need from him, I'm sure this is mostly my fault for not being strong and clear but the series made me get up and keep trying anyway.

I want to thank all the clubs who have hosted the series, we could not have asked for kinder people to look after us. Thank you also to all to volunteers on our dressage committees who make all this happen and to all the friends I have made in our dressage communities who are there for me every day. I have had the support of a few coaches over the years and they have all given me so much help in different ways that I could not have done without, thank you all so much. Most of all. thank you to Pryde's for sponsoring such great series. And of course, thanks Peanuts, you are my heart horse. you look after me every time I ride you, you try your best and you improve slowly all the time. I have retired now from competition and can only ride once or twice a week but I can just get on, never worried now that you will do something stupid and you still allow me to escape everything else while I am riding you, even if it's only for a few precious minutes.




#### Wyebo Skylark Memorial Trophy.

Known as Sky at home, Weybo Skylark was born in 1981 and was a grey 12.2hh Welsh Mountain Pony, with a heart of gold. He was purchased by Wendy and Elizabeth Hunt (now Haggett) in 1990, when Elizabeth was 7 years old.

Together, Elizabeth and Sky won at Royal Show level, would often swap the show ring hat and reins for the novelty hat and reins at the local shows to go and compete against the likes of Jive Bunny in the 'bending race' or 'flag n barrel', they also enjoyed a bit of jumping, moving sheep and cattle across paddocks and creeks at the family farm in Yankalilla, along with being an extremely successful combination in the dressage arena as a junior.

Elizabeth and Sky won many championships at Preliminary, Novice and Elementary level and the lessons and feeling that Sky taught Elizabeth, set the basics for Elizabeth's dressage career to follow, having numerous other combinations trained at home and come through the levels, all the way up to Intermediate I.

When Sky passed away in 2005, Elizabeth and Wendy felt it was only fitting to donate a memorial

#### **Dressage Stewards**

The role of Dressage Stewards at events "Help, Prevent, Intervene". Protecting the public image of our Sport has become most important over the last few years and as organisers and competitors we need to ensure that all involved in the sport are safe and respect the welfare of the horse at all times. Stewards are responsible for ensuring the welfare of horses is upheld, that the rules for the event are adhered to and that events are conducted safely. In this role they are expected to supervise training and warm-up areas, stables and other areas where horses are held, ridden or treated as well as the field of play for competitions. Stewards are not the Police! - They are there to help and assist competitors reach their goals. Prevention is always the better option! - Stewards are there to prevent any situation that may develop which could be detrimental to competitors or the sport as a whole.













# Triple Trown Challenge



The 'Triple Crown Challenge' is an MCDC initiative, offering an aggregate award calculated over three major competitions run by the Club over the course of the year.

It is open to Competitive Horse/Rider combinations. There will be SIX WINNERS, one from each Dressage level. The WINNER for each level, will have the highest aggregate score of all of the divisions within the particular level.

The Autumn Dressage Festival is the 2nd leg of the Challenge. In this leg combinations can gain bonus points if they receive over 60% in their 'B' test (e.g 2.B) for EA tests. For FEI competitors bonus points are up for grabs in PSG, Inter A or Inter 2 with scores over 60%.
