News Item From The National EADOC

Hi all,

The EA Dressage Officials Committee (EADOC) welcomes new members for the next three-year term. The EADC have ratified Elizabeth (Liz) Coe (QLD), Polly Ann Huntington (WA) and Kim Thomas (WA) back for a second term.

On behalf of the EA Dressage Community, the EADC and EADOC wish to thank both Kerrie Swan-Bates (outgoing EADOC Chair) and Jane Ventura for their dedication during their terms - their contribution is very much appreciated, as is the many hours of work they have done to help improve the educational outcomes for Judges.

The EADJC has been renamed the EADOC and the member composition has also undergone a change to ensure we address the development and progression of all Officials in our sport.

The appointment of Dressage Steward General, Cathie Drury Klein, and co-opted members, Deborah MacNicol (Dressage Technical Delegate), along with Lee Howells (EADOC Committee Secretary), brings more specialist skills on board.

The change to the EADOC structure means that the State Dressage Committees will now represent a broader array of Dressage Officials, Judges, Stewards and TDs. The National Judges' Calendar has been retitled the National Officials' Calendar and JSCs will now be known as OSCs. We anticipate the additional expertise will expand the avenues of communication and education for all Dressage Officials.

EADOC has been working to update and improve Seminar PowerPoints. The implementation of the new system allows Seminar attendees to work through Modules 2 and 3 at home and complete an online quiz. Presenters are now able to spend more time discussing / judging live horses, something the feedback from our Judges indicated was very a high priority for their development. As this system is rolled out and more feedback received, we hope the system can continue to evolve and even more changes and improvements can take place to maximise our Judges' learning outcomes.

Feedback is always welcome as this helps improve the system and keeps it dynamic.

Victoria, under the guidance of Jane Ventura, tapped into the Jo Graham webinars and these have proved to be very educational and popular all around the country. The use of technology to disseminate information has been invaluable with the problems that have arisen due to the Covid-19 restrictions. Hopefully, there can be further developments in this mode of delivery to enable all Officials to tap into educational material from all parts of the world.

We welcome to the Judge Educator list Adam Riess and Helen Whittle and hope they both enjoy their new roles.

It's also the new membership year for ESA so don't forget to renew your membership and performance cards before you enter your next competition. If you are on a Club Committee, don't forget to renew the Club membership as well.

It also means we have called for nominations for the 21 / 22 High Performance Squad. Congratulations to the riders who have worked hard over the last 12 months and achieved qualifying scores. We look forward to providing you with some interesting training opportunities in the next 12 months.

The full list of requirements to be eligible for consideration for the Squad can be found on the ESA website. For the High Performance Squad from Advanced – Grand Prix, combinations (Open, AOR, Youth or Pony) need a minimum percentage at Advanced of 67%, for the FEI Small Tour of 63% and for FEI Medium and Big Tour of 60%. For the Youth High Performance Squad, Novice – Medium Combinations need a minimum at Novice of 70%, at Elementary 65% and for Medium 63%.


Ponies

Rules regarding measurements of ponies can be found in the National Dressage Rulebook (rule 4.8.3.3) and in the EA Measuring Rules at:

www.equestrian.org.au/sites/default/files/EA-Measuring_Rules_FINAL_2017_Updated_July_2019.pdf

Ponies 8 years and over may be eligible for Life Measurement. (refer to rule 13 in the EA Measuring Rules.) Rule 13.1 of the EA Measuring Rules states that the Pony must have reached 8 years of age and have had three consecutive official EA measurements in the same height division with **two** different EA Measurers. This can be an issue in SA as there are a limited number of qualified Measurers in South Australia. If you wish to get a Lifetime Measurement please check who the Official Measurer will be before you go to a Measuring Day .

Please remember to compete at official Competitive events. For Regional Championships, State Championships, National Championships, Young Pony or CDI events all Ponies must comply with the EA Measuring Rules.

Dressage SA Performance Medals

'Recognizing and rewarding high achievements in South Australian Dressage'

Since Dressage SA started with the Performance Medal scheme in 2015, there have been nearly 200 medals awarded from Preliminary to Big Tour level! There are three types of medals awards: Gold, Silver and Bronze.

Performance Medals are awarded to the rider. The horse and rider combination must gain three aggregate scores at one level in official Competitive competitions. To find out what the minimum % is for each grade and the application form go to the DSA webpage: <https://www.sa.equestrian.org.au/dressage-sa>

You can also find here a list of all the Medal recipients since the program's inception. Congratulation to all recipients. Keep up the good work and keep sending those applications in!

Please be aware there have been rule changes and clarifications for AORs, effective 1 July 2021, as you will see below.

As per the National Rule Book:

Amateur Owner Rider (AOR) is a division of Official Competitive riders. The intent of the division is to highlight and reward non-professional riders. For the purposes of this Rule, a professional is someone who derives an income from activities in equestrian sport including breaking, training, coaching or riding horses.



It does not however exclude riders who may also earn a living running an agistment property, work in the racing industry or for a saddlery for example. It is more about recognising riders with their own horses only to ride and train, who are obliged to earn an income to support their sport outside of riding and training.

All amateur owner riders must meet the following criteria:

- a) the rider must be a Competitive member of their State branch of Equestrian Australia
- b) the horse must have a Life Registration with Equestrian Australia

c) the Horse / Pony registration lodged with Equestrian Australia must reflect the name of the Amateur Owner Rider as owner or part-owner of the horse. Leased horses are eligible if the Amateur Owner Rider competitor is reflected as the lessee on the EA horse registration of that horse

d) the rider may not receive payment for coaching

e) the rider's income may only include sponsorship

f) the horse / pony must be primarily ridden and trained by the rider / owner with only periodic ridden assistance by person(s) other than the owner, specifically during the period 4 weeks prior to the event

The change to be aware of is:

d) the rider may not receive payment for coaching. What this means for AOR riders is that *if you derive any income or reimbursement from any activities in equestrian sport including breaking, training, coaching or riding horses, you will no longer be eligible. This includes occasional coaching at home, Pony Club, ARC etc.*

Please also note c) (this has not changed but is not a commonly known rule).

The horse / pony registration lodged with Equestrian Australia must reflect the name of the Amateur Owner Rider as owner or part-owner of the horse. Leased horses are eligible if the Amateur Owner Rider competitor is reflected as the lessee on the EA horse registration of that horse. While there has been no changes here, DSA is often contacted by riders questioning ownership of horses as the name on the EA website does not match that of the rider competing.

Please check your registration information if you are leasing or part owner of a horse to ensure you are complying with this rule 😊

From the EADC

As some of you might be aware the FEI has ruled that horses are not permitted to compete in FEI events "if the horse's sensory hairs have been clipped and / or shaven or in any other way removed unless individual sensory hairs have been removed by a Veterinarian to prevent pain or discomfort for the horse."

The EADC has discussed introducing this at the National level and is looking to introduce a ban on whisker trimming with a 12 month probation period allowing for regrowth, education of riders and Officials to learn what the sensory areas are, what are acceptable and what's not.


SFDC is run from Murray
