Clarification of the HOTY awards for Moving Forward and Socials when announcing the 2025 HOTY mid-year results Note for 2025 HOTY Award - EA Rules from 1st January 2025 allow for up to 3 tests a day in official competition. For 2025 SA HOTY, only 2 best tests will count per day at any one or two-day competition Note for Century Point Award - Up to 3 tests per day will count towards the Century Point Award.

#### **EA Measuring of Horses & Ponies**

Please be aware for Pony Dressage, you MUST have a Certificate of Height that is current to compete for Pony Dressage. The next set day and the only approved measuring bay in South Australia is at the Polo Grounds at Strathalbyn – The next available day is 3<sup>rd</sup> August from 9am to 12am



Our Dressage Riders of the Future - our Youth Riders!

A very special band of Parents & Riders along with myself as chef d équipe made the long haul to the Indoor Arena University of Wagga Wagga for the 2025 Youth National Championships.

Four very talented riders had 3 glorious days of riding against their peers. They shone brightly & performed superbly.

Our youngest rider, her first interstate trip away, Zara Lally, at 11 years of aged riding her pony Trussana B, came away with personal best scores, & podium finishes with every ride. They achieved Reserve Champion Preliminary Pony with a much-deserved 1st & 3rd place. They embarked on their 1st ever FEI children's test with podium finishes of two 3rd placings.

This event heralds the first Australia versus New Zealand Team battle -every division had a NZ rider on a borrowed horse from very generous owners to allow this first Team battle for our Youth Riders.

Our very own SA rider, Keeley Menadue was chosen as one of the 13 representatives for Australia representing the Preliminary Division riding 'PS Can Dance'. With the culmination of all 12 Aussie Riders scores making up the team tally, & they WON!!!!

Keeley & PS Can Dance also produced personal best scores to become Preliminary Champion with 1st & 2nd place, then Reserve Champion Novice with 2nd & 3rd place & a brilliant last performance in the Novice Freestyle test to take out their final Win!

Micaela Butler & Regent D Andre was apart of the 3 riders who made our SA State Team along with Keeley Menadue riding PS Can Dance & Isabelle Finn riding Danson Der Von Venus

The final scores were exceeding close, with 1st place to Victoria, 2nd to NSW & 3rd to South Australia.

Micaela Butler also achieved podium finishes in the Preliminary with 6th & 7th placings with a 6th in the Novice Freestyle & 13th & 18th in the Novice tests. Micaela has a bright future ahead with a couple of more years of riding left for the Youth Nationals.

Isabelle Finn & Danson Der Von Venus also provided great scores and podium finishes with every ride to place 6th & 8th in the Novice & then lifted with better placings in the Elementary which also included her team ride with a 3rd & 7th a super effort & achievement.

All 4 SA youth riders rallied around to support each other, with the very proud parents watching and riding every step that their horses took. A fabulous display of comradery which culminated in a Pub Dinner on the Saturday evening.





- have some experience as a rider, coach, writer/penciller
- attend an EA approved G, F or G/F level seminar
- have completed the relevant sit-ins, and shadow-judged the required number of tests (more detail is in the workbook)
- have successfully completed the current G Level <u>Open</u> <u>Rule Book Test</u>, and
- complete the Australian Institute of Sport (AIS)

#### **ALL PARA RIDERS**

Please remember to email your Para Equestrian ID card or a copy of your compensating aids on the EA/FEI Master List to the club with **each entry.** Also carry it with you at each show when riding, so that it can be provided if asked for by the Steward, Judges or members of the organising committee.

**Rule 3.2.1.A** 

#### **VISION IMPAIRED RIDERS**



The rules stipulate that, <u>where possible</u>, there should be a designated safe space for vision-impaired riders to warm up independently (**Rule 4.9**). Vision-impaired riders can negotiate to have 5 minutes in the arena or have one lap on each rein and start in the arena (**Rule 8.2**).

Vision-impaired riders must wear a <u>red armband</u> during warm-up. It may be worn or removed for the test **(Rule 3.5.i).** Please notify the organising committee that you are Vision Impaired, so they can be aware of your requirements as outlined in the EA Para Rulebook and Compensating Aids List. Be mindful that this may be the first time the rider or organiser may be hearing about these requirements.

#### LOWER GRADED ATHLETES

Trainers riding an athlete's horse (grades 1, 2 and 3 only) must wear an arm band with **TRAINER** written on it. **Rule 3.7.2.H** 

#### STANDARD COMPENSATING AIDS

Please note that standard compensating aids for all classified riders are permitted as follows: - Salute with head only - Sitting or Rising Trot - Gloves - Spurs - Saddle (any type) - Soft Hand hold - Deep saddle - Elastic bands on stirrups - Enclosed stirrups - Magnetic stirrups - One Whip - Breast plate and/or neck strap - Joined rein on double bridle - Elastic inserts in reins - Safety vest (including inflatable) - Knotted Reins/Rein stops.

#### **NEXT SA CLASSIFICATION OPPORTUNITY**

#### 27th September 2025, Strathalbyn SA

The classification system is designed to enable riders to compete on equal terms against one another in Para Dressage. Athletes are classified according to their disability across a range of five grades, which determine the complexity of the movements that they perform with their horses. There are five classification grades: Grade I (1) is for athletes whose impairment has the greatest impact on their ability to ride, whilst Grade V (5) is for athletes whose impairment has the least impact on their ability to ride.

The best 12 tests for each combination will be counted for the Leaderboard final

A minimum of two DCSA shows must be attended for points to count

Points will not be back dated.

One rider may enter the same award on multiple horses or may enter different horses for different awards but cannot nominate the same horse for multiple awards.

#### THE SIX CATEGORIES FOR DCSA CLUB CHAMPIONS

- Youth
- Senior Prelim & Novice (AOR & Open)
- Senior Elementary, Medium & Advanced (AOR & Open)
- FEI
- Pony
- CR

Categories must be correctly nominated on the entry form & checked by the competitor prior to the show via the official published draw. Categories will not be changed on the day of the show, & points will be allocated as per the results.

Youth rider age is from the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns ten years for horses and eight years for ponies to the end of the calendar year in which the rider turns 21. This is a combined group based on current EA Rules for Juniors and Young-Riders.

To qualify as an Amateur Owner Rider (AOR), riders must declare that they meet the criteria as set out in the National Dressage Rules.4.6.1. It is the AOR's responsibility to ensure they have made it clear on their entries that they are entering as an AOR and to ensure that the draw clearly states they are competing as an AOR - this cannot be backdated. If the rider is not listed on the draw an AOR combination, they cannot accrue points for that specific competition. The onus is on the rider to make it clear prior to the competition.

CR (Closed Restricted) is for Member entries only. To gain Leaderboard points in the CR category, the rider and horse are to be unofficial.

Points are awarded for placings as per the tables below for the tests at each DCSA competition.

If there is equality in points accrued at the completion of the calendar year, the next best-placed tests will be used to determine a winner. If there is still equality, then all will be announced as winners.







A big thank you to our hardworking canteen manager – Karen and everyone who provided delicious soup and cakes.


To our dedicated volunteers who set up the arenas in wild weather – you are the reason we can run these events.




