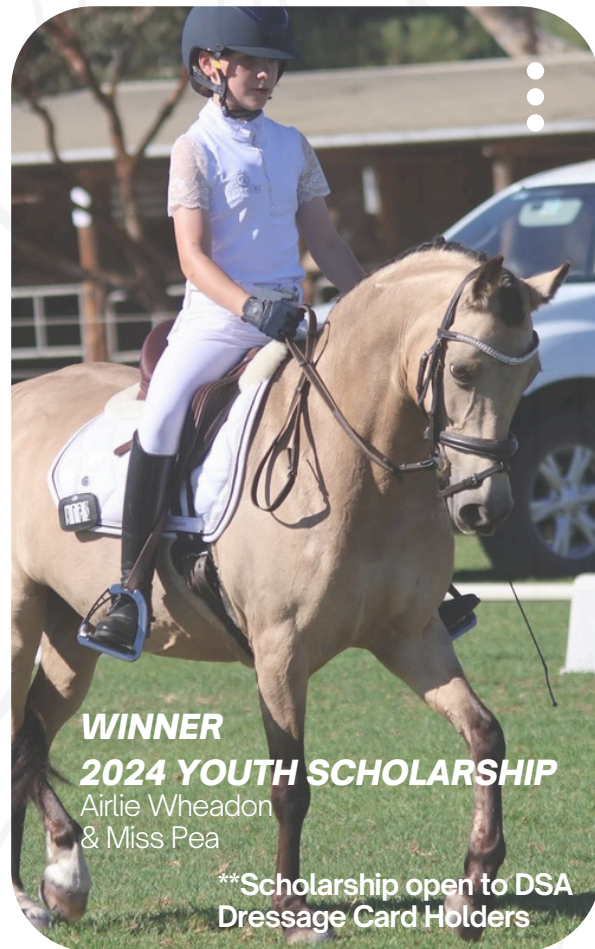

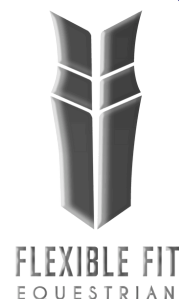

Summary - How to become a Dressage Judge

Equestrian Australia has developed a National Officiating Accreditation Scheme (NOAS) that sets the requirements for becoming a judge.

To become a new judge, applicants must:

- be at least 17 years of age
- be a member of the EA (at least Supporter category)
- complete the G – Level Expression of Interest Form, on page 4 of **[How to Become a Dressage Judge \(G-E\)- Jan 2024.pdf](#)**
- have some experience as a rider, coach, writer/penciller
- attend an EA approved G, F or G/F level seminar
- have completed the relevant sit-ins, and shadow-judged the required number of tests (more detail is in the workbook)
- have successfully completed the current G Level [Open Rule Book Test](#), and
- complete the Australian Institute of Sport (AIS) Community Officiating Principles Online Course **[Essential Skills | Australian Sports Commission](#)**

WHAT IS VIRTUS?

LET'S UNDERSTAND PARA & VIRTUS AS A SPORT

VIRTUS Virtus is the international sporting organisation for people with intellectual impairment. Virtus advocates inclusion in sport and building elite pathways for athletes with intellectual impairment to compete at the highest levels of international sport. Australia first became involved in Virtus Equestrian in 2022. It is still early days for our athletes, with numbers steadily increasing. Australia's first equestrian global games were in Paris in 2023. Our team won Gold! This was a wonderful outcome for our rider and supporters.

WHAT OPPORTUNITIES DOES VIRTUS PROVIDE?

LOCALLY

In SA, dressage clubs have begun to incorporate Virtus within Para Equestrian competitions. This has enabled riders to ride at their own level with support from family, coaches and often their support workers.

For athletes thinking about being involved in Virtus, they don't even have to have their own horse!

INTERNATIONALLY

The Virtus Equestrian competition offers three online international video dressage competitions a year. This makes it accessible for athletes and teams across the world. One of the advantages of online competition is that athletes can ride in a familiar environment with no crowds or distractions as they learn their craft.

There are also International Championships and Global Games face to face. This involves teams travelling internationally to compete on borrowed horses.

Virtus also provides development classes to help develop riders' skills to progress to the Competition level.

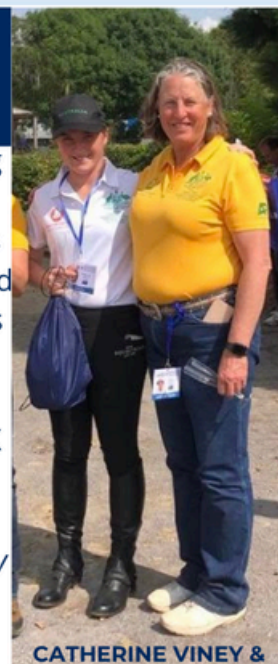

The **best 12 tests** for each combination will be counted for the Leaderboard final

A **minimum of two** DCSA shows must be attended for points to count

Points will not be back dated.

One rider may enter the same award on multiple horses or may enter different horses for different awards but cannot nominate the same horse for multiple awards.

THE SIX CATEGORIES FOR DCSA CLUB CHAMPIONS

- Youth
- Senior Prelim & Novice (AOR & Open)
- Senior Elementary, Medium & Advanced (AOR & Open)
- FEI
- Pony
- CR

Categories must be correctly nominated on the entry form & checked by the competitor prior to the show via the official published draw. Categories will not be changed on the day of the show, & points will be allocated as per the results.

Youth rider age is from the beginning of the calendar year in which the rider turns ten years for horses and eight years for ponies to the end of the calendar year in which the rider turns 21. This is a combined group based on current EA Rules for Juniors and Young-Riders.

To qualify as an Amateur Owner Rider (AOR), riders must declare that they meet the criteria as set out in the National Dressage Rules.4.6.1. It is the AOR's responsibility to ensure they have made it clear on their entries that they are entering as an AOR and to ensure that the draw clearly states they are competing as an AOR - this cannot be backdated. If the rider is not listed on the draw an AOR combination, they cannot accrue points for that specific competition. The onus is on the rider to make it clear prior to the competition.

CR (Closed Restricted) is for Member entries only. To gain Leaderboard points in the CR category, the rider and horse are to be unofficial.

Points are awarded for placings as per the tables below for the tests at each DCSA competition.

If there is equality in points accrued at the completion of the calendar year, the next best-placed tests will be used to determine a winner. If there is still equality, then all will be announced as winners.

DCSA reserves the right to review if and when needed, and the DCSA decision is final.

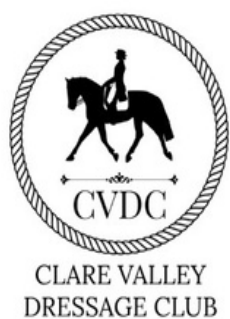

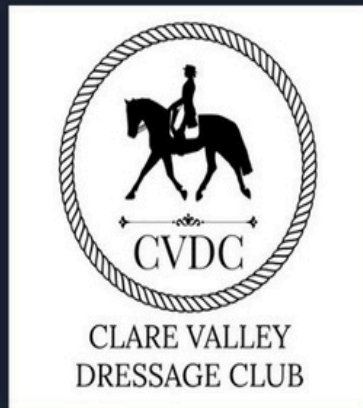
