Selection events will include AOR classes.

Clubs need to apply on the approved form to run Horse of the Year & Squad selection events. These events must run: EA tests (2 each level), FEI, AOR, Youth, Pony.

Clubs may get dispensation to run AOR & selection events not including FEI.



#### Judges' Education Opportunities

Due to the COVID-19 travel restrictions, Judge Education Seminars and Workshops have been on hold and we are working to reschedule any that were cancelled. The following Seminars have been planned for the remainder of the year:

- 1. Two Regional half day Workshops September (dates and location TBC)
- D / E Seminar 4<sup>th</sup> October with local Judge Educator Barrie Stratton, venue TBA.
- Young Horse 29<sup>th</sup> November with Sue Cunningham -TBC

For Judge Educators and Mentors there is also an online workshop being held on 14<sup>th</sup> September with Mary Seefried and Jane Ventura.

Please note there will be no A / B / C Seminar this year, due to restrictions and difficulties in travel for our Australian FEI Judge Educators.

#### SA Dressage Judges' Committee

The SADJC is a small Committee that meets regularly online with occasional face to face meetings at the EA office in Mount Barker. The workload is much less than on a Discipline Committee, but still requires a regular commitment, attendance at the Seminars we organise and enthusiasm for the development of Dressage Judges in SA. We are looking for an extra member to share the workload. Judges of all levels are invited to express their interest in joining: please contact Liz Duncan.

#### Other News from the Equestrian Australia Dressage Judges' Committee (EADJC):

The Australian Dressage Judges' Committee is working on how to attract more Dressage Judges, noting that even the G-level Judges are mostly over 30. Our Committee has put forward a submission with suggestions on how the upgrading process could be modified to make it easier while still maintaining the standard of Judge education. South Australia needs more Judges at all levels and we encourage anyone that has an interest in the future of dressage to become involved. It's a way to give back to the sport and has great benefits for riders wanting to improve their test riding and understanding of what the Judges are looking for.

## Judges Back To Judging

#### From Lesley Sullivan:

Thanks to DNSW for compiling this information.

I hope this email finds you all well and safe from COVID19. As you can probably all see, competitions are beginning to be scheduled which raises the issue of Judge Safety regarding social distancing within the demands of judging.

Before accepting an invitation to judge, please consider how you feel about judging and the effect the interaction may have on the friends and family around you with lowered immune systems due to chronic health issues and any other serious illnesses. It is easy for the riders to participate, they arrive, ride and leave. Their social distancing is easily established, however ours is not. We are often sitting in a car for hours with someone we don't know, or multiple writers that we don't know. It is also winter and cold so windows are wound up, making the chance of transferring infection more likely.

As Judges we have several options (but are not limited to):

- Bring our own writer / family member with us and judge normally.
- Work with your writer / s who are provided by the Club as you normally would.
- Ask your writer to sit in another car or at a table next to yours (or in the near vicinity) and communicate by phone, we suggest on speaker / hands free.
- Judge alone and only fill in the marks with no remarks and make a summary of the test in the Collectives.
- Ask your writer to sit in the back seat of the car, diagonally opposite you which should provide about 1.5m in distance between you.

- It is beneficial not to change your writer during the day if possible have the same writer all day. That means you are potentially less exposed.
- the wearing of a mask and the frequent use of hand sanitizer / washing hands is also strongly recommended

When asked to judge, ask what plans are in place to maintain social distancing. If the OC plans do not meet your requirements or make you feel safe, make it clear to the organisers how you intend to interact with your writer.

You are not obliged to do anything that you feel puts you in danger, or makes you uncomfortable which does mean that you need to take charge of the situation and nominate the conditions you require to judge on the day.

It is too late to change things once you arrive at a competition and find you are not happy with the conditions, this is also unfair on the OC.

Please liaise with the Clubs who have booked you to judge and discuss your needs.

It is very important that whichever option you chose in relation to judging and interacting with your writer that the conditions meet the COVID restrictions/policies in place in your particular State/area.

Wishing you all happy judging as we move forward from the COVID pandemic.

#### **President's Report**

Hi everyone:

At last Clubs have been able to resume competitions at their home grounds with Social Distancing rules and added health / safety regulations.

July 12th was our first competition since the restrictions began and was well attended, despite the unexpected deluge of rain on Saturday night. The grounds held up reasonably well but the tracks did become a bit muddy by the afternoon. Well done to all our competitors and a big Thank You to those who helped dismantle and pack up the arenas at the end of the day.

Due to all the uncertainty and restrictions about travelling to and from SA we have decided that there is not enough time to organize Sponsorship and Interstate Judges to enable us to hold the Spring Festival in October and do this prestigious event justice.

Instead we are running a weekend of dressage. Saturday 10 October is a Protocol ("Critique") day plus the usual Closed Unrestricted competition. We have five confirmed Instructors / Judges for the Protocol classes: Ruth Schneeberger, Linda O'Leary, Jody Cavuoto, Kerry Kirchner and Esther Cruikshank. The cost of the Protocol entries is higher than the CUR classes but it allows a rider to have a one-onone 30 minute arena session. You can ride your nominated test, be critiqued and ride it again, or spend the entire time as an instruction type exercise- your choice. It's a wonderful opportunity to introduce a green horse or rider to a competition atmosphere without pressure or just to have a practice session to move up a level.

Other arenas will host a separate CUR competition so you may ride in either the Protocol classes, Unrestricted classes or do a combination of both. The CUR classes will not necessarily with the same judge however - the overall draw is determined by the number of competitors and which combinations of classes they enter. The Protocol classes often run all day but there will be a reserve list in case of scratchings (contact the Secretary - text 0429 190 653).

On Sunday 11th October we will host a Competitive, Participant and Closed Unrestricted competition. We are in the process of organizing some special prizes with Sponsors so keep an eye on our Facebook page for more details closer to the date.

September will again include the Golden Oldies classes. Our Club Championships will be run in November with great prizes and rosettes. Horseland Mt Barker will be our Major Sponsor again this year.

We have extended our membership year from 30 June to 31 December as we missed three months of competition with Covid-19. Existing memberships will carry through to 31 December and new memberships are half price.

The Cover Photo of Penny Stewart on her lovely horse Capratanz BHI is a memorial and tribute to her brave fight with cancer and her determination to ride and compete (very successfully) whilst enduring treatment. She is sadly missed.

- Don't forget about the new Horse Identification for competitions. Your horse must have its bridle number on it at all times. A quick way to have it on your halter is to use a sticky label and write the number on it.
- To be able to look at the competition results during an event you will need to download the "Nominate Scoreboard" app.
- The Club now has free WIFI at the grounds that will support checking your emails.

We are offering the Online service ongoing so riders can submit their videos any time they are ready!

Then finally the day dawned, when the horses could hit the sand again!

We had the best entries at our Club shows for a couple of years – and perfect weather. A magnificent Hills equestrian setting at the historic Yucanta property, home to Danson Dressage and a group of enthusiastic and talented riders with their equines made our dressage show comeback everything we hoped for!

Riders and their crews were very respectful of the Covid conditions in place and our Committee worked hard to ensure that the show ran without a hitch. Special thanks to Sondra and the whole Danson ground crew for their help during the show, and Heather Currie for being so passionately enthusiastic and easy to work with, last sighted the night before the show raking the arenas in the twilight.

Being the first event held at Danson Equestrian Centre, it was a learning experience for everyone, and we followed the show up with a survey to ensure we can make the August show even better. Thank you to everyone who took the time to complete the survey and help us by making comments where requested. The equestrian facility is a work in progress and will get better and better as it continues to be developed. We will make a few changes where physically possible in line with the feedback, so keep an eye on our Facebook page as we put our plans in action for the August show.

We will be donating 50% of the raffle income to the Ovarian Cancer Research Foundation in support of the Letitia Linke Research Foundation Inc, which is a Not For Profit registered charity named after the late Letitia Linke. She died of the disease aged 38 and was the mother of two young boys. After her diagnosis Letitia set about raising awareness of the signs and symptoms of Ovarian Cancer and raising funds for research. She knew this would not change her pathway, however her passion was to find an early detection test so other women might not have to go through what she did. In one year, she raised in excess of \$100,000. All this while undergoing chemotherapy, radiotherapy and multiple surgeries.

In Australian one women dies every 8 hours from Ovarian Cancer. Cervical screening and HPV testing do not detect Ovarian Cancer and treatment has remained almost unchanged in 30 years. In Australia the overall five-year survival rate for OC is 46% with breast cancer at 91%.

We are very proud to support this charity, especially given the very high percentage of women that compete in equestrian sport.

Although social distancing and hygiene will strictly apply under the Covid 19 Plan, our August show has relaxed conditions under the SA Government guidelines, so we are looking forward to having great coffee and catering back, and a crowd of dressage supporters to enjoy the day.
