

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All Exhibitors must be members of the Society – Membership fee is \$18:00
Each rider must be a member and will be issued with a wristband which must be worn during competition.

STRICTLY NO WRISTBAND = NO RIDING, NO EXCEPTIONS!!

**** WRISTBANDS ARE TO BE COLLECTED FROM SECRETARY IN RING CENTRE
ON THE MORNING OF COMPETITION - strictly before 8:00am****

2. Protest to be in writing and accompanied by \$50 fee to the Secretary within 20 minutes of the incident to be refunded if protest upheld.
3. Committee reserves the right to measure entries where height is specified.
4. Stallions are not permitted to compete in any other class than specified.
5. All Stallions or Colts 1 year and over to be shown in a bridle with a bit.
6. All competitors are to respect other exhibitor's rights by ensuring that their exhibits are given adequate space. Please advise Ring Centre if you have any concerns.
7. Only financial members of the Breed Societies are eligible to show in their respective Classes.
8. All Competitors must wear correct riding attire and protective headgear.
9. Ages stipulated are the age of the riders on the first day of the Show.
10. Exhibits must be under effective control by a capable handler/rider at all times.
11. The exhibitor of any loose horse/pony may be liable for a fine of up to \$200 at the Committee's discretion.
12. No horses to be tethered to the fences.
13. Dogs to be kept on a leash or tied up at all times – away from horse and cattle areas.
14. Events may be added, deleted or combined by Committee's discretion/right.
15. Horses are not to be lunged on the oval. A working area is available on the grounds.
16. Stable hire \$15 a day - to be booked and paid for with entries. Preference will be given to stallions and all other applications will be considered on a "first in best dressed" basis. Stables must be left clean. If stables are not left in a clean manner – refusal WILL OCCUR the following year!!!
17. **UNDER NO CIRCUMSTANCES ARE THERE TO BE ANY TRUCKS PARKED IN NON TRUCK PARKING AREAS** – If you are asked to move and refusal takes place entries will be withdrawn and you will be asked to remove yourself and horses from the grounds.
18. Committee will consider refund on presentation of veterinary certificate.
19. **Camping is permitted at the grounds in designated areas.**
20. **Horses are not to enter the Dairy Cattle area due to animal health restrictions.**
21. The Society will not be held responsible for any accident that may be caused to, or by, any horse and it shall be a condition of entry that each nominator hold the Society blameless and shall indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from any such incident. No person shall be allowed in the ring during judging except the Judges, Stewards, Reporters, Secretaries and persons in charge of exhibits, unless invited by the President of the Society, or with the written consent of the Secretary or Convener.
22. Any person giving wrong description or giving annoyance to the Show Officials or Judges is liable to disqualification and may be barred from future shows. Any act that, in the opinion of the Judges, Stewards or Convener, is deemed cruel or neglectful (e.g. whip marks) will cause the exhibitor to be barred from the class. Severe cases will be reported to appropriate authority
23. **PLEASE NOTE:** Any exhibits from properties located within the proclaimed branched broomrape quarantine zone, or from out-of-zone properties infested with this weed, must be accompanied by a statutory declaration and appropriate certificate of approval.
24. Once any exhibit has won first prize in two **Royal Show qualifying events** they are not permitted to compete in any further qualifying event. I.e. in the **SPIRIT OF FAIR PLAY** – once you have gained your two wins you are still able to show but not in the qualifying events.
25. **Horses to be shown as either a hack or a hunter - not both**
26. Each horse's name and riders name need to be included on the entry form.
27. Approved Helmets AS/AN 3838 or EN 1384 and boots must be worn when riding horses including in practice areas
28. All horses must walk in any area that is not a practice or competition arena and must obey directions from show appointed grounds people.
29. If judging clashes, events will not be delayed. No refunds.
30. Led rider classes (excluding dedicated leading rein pony classes) are for riders that have not yet mastered riding on their own. If a rider enters a led rider class this prevents the same rider from then riding in any open competition off the lead for the rest of the show program.
31. The committee reserves the right to alter/combine or delete events on the day
32. The convenor reserves the right to refuse any entry without notice. No refunds on entries to be paid including on the day of competition.
33. All competitors compete absolutely at their own risk

34. Random swabbing may take place at this show – please contact EA. re anti-doping policy and banned substances.
35. SUNDAY: ANY exhibitor competing in RINGS 6 and 7 are STRICTLY not eligible to compete in rings 1 – 4 – APART FROM LOCAL RIDER, MOUNT & BRED IN ENCOURAGE RING – OPEN TO ALL LOCAL COMPETITORS & COMPETITORS IN ROYAL QUALIFIER RING IN LEADING REIN CAN ALSO COMPETE IN TOPSY EVENTS (RING 7), However if you do your rider in Rings 1- 4, you cannot in ring 7 and vice versa!
36. SUNDAY Ring 1 - 4, are affiliated with the Royal Agricultural & Horticultural Society and therefore are Royal Qualifying events.
37. Ring 5 (WORKING HUNTER) is OPEN to ALL competitors competing on the day.
38. **PIC Number is COMPULSORY and MUST be on the entry form!**
39. **ALL COMPETITORS NEED TO BE MEMBERS OF THE MURRAY BRIDGE A & H SOCIETY TO COMPETE AT THIS COMPETITION**

A Trophy (donor to be advised) will be awarded to the exhibitor gaining the highest aggregate number of points in at least three (2) Southern Country Shows during 2015. Points for aggregate trophies are only included from the Annual Show results (excepting gymkhana events and breed classes)





Young Judges Competition has been revamped into a series backed by Show Horse Council SA, being renamed the SHC SA Young Judges Series. Murray Bridge Ag Show will be the first of a selection of shows to hold the event with a Final to be held at the 2017 SHC HOTY.

This event is open to young competitors aged 16 years and under 25 years.

Note: if you win at one of the selected shows you are ineligible to compete at any other qualifier for that year. By winning one of the qualifying shows you are eligible to compete at the Final.

Showhorse Class

Retired Racehorse, Showhorse Class is exclusive to retired thoroughbred racehorses and will be held at selected events throughout the State.

There are thousands of retired racehorses in South Australia succeeding in their post racing lives as show horses and many have gone on to win major shows including Grand Nationals, Royal Shows, and Horse of the Year. Thoroughbreds are a highly sought after breed for equestrian disciplines because of their versatility and striking presence. To be eligible to compete in the Retired Racehorse Showhorse class, horses must have competed in an official trial or started in a race, locally, nationally or internationally.

This Showhorse class is open to any height, weight, hunter or hack. (Sportshorses / Allrounder Class horses are not eligible to compete in this class).






